INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL HIGHER EDUCATION AND ACADEMIC MOBILITY OF YOUTH IN CONTEMPORARY INTEGRATION PROCESSES INFORMATION LETTER

Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence together with International organizations and network Research Centre at National Research Tomsk State University organize an International Summer School "Higher Education and Academic Mobility of Youth in Contemporary Integration Processes". The Summer School is intended for students, including Masters and PhD students from Russia and European countries. The event will take place at Tomsk State University from 2 to July 5, 2017.

Today young people are actively involved in international mobility related to education or work. Such integration projects as the European Union and the Eurasian Economic Union create conditions contributing to youth mobility. The main task of Summer School is to present and discuss international youth mobility experience aimed at obtaining professional education, practice and work in the framework of integration processes. During the Summer School the following topics will be discussed:

- Integration of higher education
- The opportunities for academic mobility in the framework of integration projects and international organizations
- Higher school and employment assistance for graduates
- Higher education and the labor market: groups of interests and opportunities for dialogue
- Problems of recognition of qualifications in international mobility
- Social guarantees for participants of academic mobility program
- Accessibility of higher education for foreign students

Working languages of the Summer School are Russian and English. The Summer School participants will receive certificates of attendance.

To participate in the Summer School, please, send us the following information: 1) personal details in the application form, 2) a motivation letter (Appendix 1), 3) proposal of the presentation, 4) a recommendation letter from the scientific advisor, certified by his / her signature and the stamp of the university / faculty (scan forms).

Scanned copies of certificates or diplomas confirming English language level and documents confirming academic achievements of a candidate are welcome.

Requirements for the Presentation/Paper

The paper should be submitted in electronic form (Microsoft Word or Open Office format), up to 15 000 characters, format A4, font size is 10, Times New Roman, 1 space, all margins are 20 mm, paragraph indent -0.5 cm, alignment justified, page numbering starting with the 1st page. References should be organized in square brackets [1. c. 28]. File name of the document should have author's name in English and a standard extension (.rtf, .doc, .docx, .odt): ex. ivanov.doc.

Proposals should be carefully edited. The following information should be listed, each time with a new line, in the beginning of a paper: 1) initials and surname of the author (centered, bold type), 2) title of the article (bold type), 3) brief annotation of the article (500 words), 4) 3-5 key words.

The list of references should be located at the end of the paper and separated by an empty line, numbered (starting with the first number), preceded by the word "Notes" and made in the order of mentioning or citing in a text of a statement (not in alphabetical order!). Only one source is allowed to be given under one number. Registration of bibliographic references must comply with a standard of Russian Federation GOST 7.0.5-2008. After references should be given information about adviser – academic degree, rank, full name.
